**PUEBLO, CO., May 4, 2010** – The U.S. Forest Service – Pike and San Isabel National Forests, Cimarron and Comanche National Grasslands (PSICC) will have various campgrounds opening later in the season due to some late heavy spring snows. Even though temperatures are warming, there will be several campgrounds that won't be opening as scheduled.

The following campgrounds' status should be checked prior to travel:

Kite Lake, Selkirk, Lost Park, Weston Pass, Kenosha Pass, Devil's Head, Alvarado, Purgatorie, Bear Lake and Blue Lake

Local Ranger Districts are a great resource for campground information. It is advised you contact the Ranger District closest to your preferred campground.
